

Culture Guide



Allium 'New Moon'

Breeder: Brent Horvath, Intrinsic Perennials, Pioneer Gardens

Zone hardiness: 4-9

Bloom time: Mid-late summer.

Habit: Upright

Branching: singular and upright

Flower size: 5cm

Flower form: Individual Height: 12-15" high Spread: 6-18" wide

Exposure: Performs best in full sun and some light shade.

Water: Prefers regular moisture, let dry in between, can tolerate

drought.

Fertilizer: medium amount required, through foliar feed

PGR: None necessary

pH: 5.8-6.5 **EC:** 1.5-3

Temperature for rooting: needs cooled temperatures

Pinching: None

Scheduling: Early spring to early summer

Pests: Onion flies (Delia), onion thrips, and stem nematode

(Ditylenchus)

Disease: Smut, rust, smudge (Colletotrichum), onion white rot

Always follow label instructions carefully.

Test on a small portion of the crop prior to widespread application.
